If one block Reg. 15 will apply. If more than one block, seeding will be introduced and determined by the Tournament Committee.

Draw & Process (Reg. 14(d)) (or blocks). Advanced Doubles Play - Law 42.

Draw & Process (or blocks). Advanced Singles Play - Law 36. Restricted to handicap 3 and over.
(Event not played in 2017)
4. **RESTRICTED HANDICAP SINGLES - Atlanta Trophy**
Draw & Process (or blocks). Handicap Play. Three hour time limit. Restricted to handicap of 6 or over.

Handicap Singles Play : XY or XYZ - Laws 38 and 39 (or blocks). Three hour time limit.

NOTE TO ALL PLAYERS

CUPS & TROPHIES may be retained by their winners until the start of next tournament when they should be returned, having been appropriately engraved at the winner's own expense beforehand, to the Manager or SACA Secretary. Trophies may not be taken out of South Africa but overseas-based winners will have engraving done on their behalf by SACA

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

The **SACA GOLF CROQUET RULES 2014** and **SACA REGULATIONS FOR TOURNAMENTS 2014** shall apply, including any amendments circulated by SACA prior to the tournament.

1. Entries on the official entry form must reach the Tournament Manager or Convenor by 14 October 2018 and the appropriate entrance fees must be paid to SACA by 14 October 2018. **Entrants are advised to PLEASE check with the Manager or Convenor timeously that their entry forms were received.**
2. Printed draw sheets will be issued to each player on the first day of the tournament.
3. Unless otherwise advised, competitors are to report to CCJ, Auckland Park by 08h30 on 29 October for Association Croquet and to CCJ, Auckland Park by 08h15 on 5 November for Golf Croquet.
4. It is each player's responsibility to find out when and where he/she is due to play each day and to ascertain the details of each match. (i.e. whether it is time limited, handicap, level, double banked, etc). The Manager will supply this information on request but it is the responsibility of players to ensure that they have all necessary information and data relevant to their matches.
5. Competitors are advised to read 'SACA Regulations for Tournaments 2014'. Special attention is drawn to the following:
 - (a) The tournament programme may be altered at the discretion of the Manager or in agreement with the Tournament Committee. (Regulation M2.c).
 - (b) Leave of absence will be granted only in exceptional circumstances, and only with the Manager's permission. If leave of absence has not been granted and players are absent or otherwise unable to play when called upon to do so by the Manager they are liable to be disqualified. Competitors are requested to note on their entry form whether any leave of absence may be required. (Regulation M2.b)
 - (c) The Manager is authorised to impose a time limit on an entire event, or any round in an event and on any game. (Regulations M2.c / 1, 2, 3 and 6).
 - (d) The Manager is empowered to introduce the Two-Life variation on any event that is not a first-class event. (Regulation M2.c.7).
 - (e) Ties for winning/progressive positions in a block will be resolved according to the current Regulations F2.b and F2.c.
6. A telephone contact number is essential during the tournament. Home, business or mobile telephone numbers should be supplied in case a problem arises at the draw or subsequently.

7. Play will continue while there is sufficient light. Floodlights can be used if necessary at the discretion of the Manager.
8. As soon as possible after the end of each match players are to report the score and to check whether they are required for further play. Even if not scheduled to play players must still check with the Manager before leaving the venue.
9. Dawson balls will be used. This can be varied by the Manager if necessary.
10. A Players' Briefing will be held before the first day's play for both Association and Golf Croquet.
11. For the Golf Croquet Event, the Manager will use his best endeavours to maximise the block sizes used in Restricted Events so as to provide players only entering Restricted Events with as many games as possible.
