NOTE TO ALL PLAYERS

CUPS & TROPHIES may be retained by the winner/s until the start of next tournament when they should be returned to the Manager or SACA Secretary, having been appropriately engraved at the winner's own expense beforehand. Trophies **may not** be taken out of South Africa but overseas-based winners will have engraving done on their behalf by SACA.

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

The SACA GOLF CROQUET RULES 2018 and SACA REGULATIONS FOR TOURNAMENTS 2014 shall apply, including any amendments circulated by SACA prior to the tournament.

1. Entries on the official entry form, together with proof of payment, must reach the SACA Treasurer, Richard Prosser: rprosser@telkomsa.net together with proof of payment,, by 26 September 2021. A copy to be sent to Tournament Manager, Noeline Kirsten : kersnoeline@telomsa.net. **Entrants are advised to PLEASE check with Noeline Kirsten timeously that their entry forms were received.**
2. Printed draw sheets will be issued to each player as soon as possible once the draw has been completed.
3. Unless otherwise advised, competitors are to report to Port Alfred Croquet Cub on Sunday 31 October 2021 for induction at 6.00pm.
4. It is each player's responsibility to find out when and where he/she is due to play each day and to ascertain the details of each match. There will be no timed matches. Matches may be double banked. The Manager will supply this information on request but it is the responsibility of players to ensure that they have all necessary information and data relevant to their matches.
5. Competitors are advised to read 'SACA Regulations for Tournaments 2014'. Special attention is drawn to the following:
 - (a) The tournament programme may be altered at the discretion of the Manager or in agreement with the Tournament Committee. (Regulation M2.c).
 - (b) Leave of absence will be granted only in exceptional circumstances, and only with the Manager's permission. If leave of absence has not been granted and players are absent or otherwise unable to play when called upon to do so by the Manager they are liable to be disqualified. Competitors are requested to note on their entry form whether any leave of absence may be required. (Regulation M2.b)
 - (c) The Manager is authorised to impose a time limit on a match should it be considered necessary. (Regulations M2.c / 1, 2, 3 and 6).
6. A telephone contact number is essential during the tournament. Home, business or mobile telephone numbers should be supplied in case a problem arises at the draw or subsequently.
7. Play may continue while there is sufficient light.
8. As soon as possible after the end of each match players are to report the score and to check whether they are required for further play. Even if not scheduled to play players must still check with the Manager before leaving the venue.
9. Dawson balls will be used. This can be varied by the Manager if necessary.
